VIP SERVICE for 2011 Youth and ROTC Day

Priority Drop Off - How to take full advantage of this New VIP Service

- **Purchase your **VIP** tickets and register your group by Monday, September 12, 2011**
- **Groups will receive game credentials and bus access passes by mail (Please indicate on your registration form the number of Buses and/or Vans that will be used to transport your group.)**
- **VIP Buses and/or Vans will be allowed to enter the Game Zone {Entrance on Russell and Buckley Streets (Gate #1)} **No Cars****
- **Guests will be dropped off in front of Bulldog Stadium**
- **As a reminder, **ALL** activities with the exception of ROTC will be at Bulldog Stadium and in the Game Zone.**
- **Advance ticket purchases are very important as groups come to campus for this year's activities. Take full advantage of our **VIP SERVICE**, pay early, receive your credentials, and enjoy priority drop-off in front of Oliver C. Dawson Stadium.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Ticket prices are \$10.00 for youth (17 and under) chaperones (one \$10.00 chaperon ticket per group of 10 youth), and general admission is \$25.00. Tickets must be purchased using the order form provided. For information regarding tickets, please contact our ticket office at 1-800-298-9157 or 1-803-536-8579.
- Box lunches can be purchased from Popeye's (our official vendor for Youth and ROTC Day). To order, complete the Popeye's order form provided in your activities booklet and fax to 1-803-533-7688. The price of the group meal is \$4.39 which includes tax. Popeye's contact number is 1-803-707-7412. ALL ORDERS must be placed by [Tuesday, September 20, 2011](#). Delivery is scheduled for 12:15 p.m. at Gate #4. Lunch can be eaten inside of the stadium in the general seating section.
- Tailgate spots are available at \$50.00 per spot. Please reserve your spot using the registration form included in your activities booklet. Tailgate spots must be purchased in advance of game day.
- Free bus and van parking with proper Youth/ROTC credentials is available at the future site of the Clyburn Center.

All patrons are encouraged to purchase your tickets early. No tickets will be mailed after the Monday, September 12, 2011 deadline. All prepaid tickets must be picked up before game day.

SC State Football Game Zone and Ticket Policy

The SC State Athletics Department would like to thank you for your continued support of all of our teams. In that spirit, we are constantly assessing our processes and making modifications that will make you, our fans, more comfortable when you come to campus to the football games. We invite you to read the information below that will help you navigate. As you read, look at the accompanying map for clearer understanding of the Game Zone and The STATE Club Parking Guidelines.

- (1) Anyone entering campus from **Gate 2 (Pinckney/Russell Streets)** and **Gate 3 (Magnolia Street/Highway 601)** will be charged **\$5.00 per vehicle** to park on campus on game day. Faculty-staff-student decals will be honored only at Gates 2 and 3 on game-days (no charge).
- (2) Fans entering campus from **Gate 1 (Buckley/Russell Streets)**, **Gate 4 (Buckley/Goff Streets)**, or **Gate 5 (Chestnut Street/Highway 21 Bypass)** will be required to have valid reserved parking passes purchased in advance of game day in addition to a game ticket for each person in the vehicle. When available, game-day parking will be **\$10 per car (only through Gate 4)**, and **each person in the vehicle will be required to have a game ticket**.
- (3) **Pedestrians entering the GAME ZONE will be required to have a game ticket for entry into the area.** Points of entry to the Game Zone include (on-campus) State Street at Rowe Hall and Naylor Street at Mitchell Hall as well as Gates 1, 4, and 5.
- (4) Tickets will be available on game-day at various satellite ticket locations on campus at Gates 1, 4, 5, and at the University Bookstore. For best results, tickets may be purchased in advance (prior to game day) through the SC State Ticket Office by calling 803-536-8579 or 1-800-298-9157.

- (5) Fans who have items at **WILL CALL** should enter through **Gate 2 (Pinckney/Russell Streets)** and come to the **Crawford-Zimmerman Building** lobby for pick up. Home and Visiting Teams PlayersøGuests, High School Coaches and Recruits should enter through **Gate 2 (Pinckney/Russell Streets)** and pick up wristbands in the **Crawford-Zimmerman Building** lobby.
- (6) **Fans are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance of game day** and arrive early for home games.

2011 STATE Club Parking Guidelines

- ✓ Members are reminded that STATE Club membership beginning at the Rally level includes ðone ðseason ticket. If you need to purchase additional tickets, for your convenience, you may buy all of your tickets through the STATE Club. **All** season tickets orders are forwarded to the SCSU ticket office for processing. The STATE Club does not allocate tickets. You will still be able to reclaim your same seats and parking space (s) if you renew by **July 15, 2011**. Purchasing parking amenities only will not allow you in the Game Zone. You must have a game ticket.
- ✓ To help ensure a safe and enjoyable Bulldog experience for everyone, the STATE Club Security and SC State Campus Police will patrol The STATE Club Tailgating and parking areas. We ask that you continue to observe parking rules and procedures while on University property. Please avoid situations that may lead to unfriendly confrontations. We encourage you to bring **all observed** parking violations to the attention of security or the STATE Club Parking Committee

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to make everyone aware of the changes in policy.
