1. Each requesting charitable organization must submit a completed application by the Chapter's required deadline for consideration.
2. Only one application by a charitable organization will be reviewed by the Chapter's Student Recruitment Committee.
3. The number of youth tickets will be limited to 25 per charitable organization.
4. The application is available on the Chapter's website at www.capitalcitybulldogs.com.
5. The Chapter will purchase tickets only and no meals will be provided by the Chapter.
